You may offer Infant Tylenol 0.8 (12-18lbs)/1.2ml (18-23lbs) Now and again in 4-6hrs.

Dimetapp allergy or Benadryl "allergy" liquid for congestion 1/4tsp = 1.2cc every 8hrs

Children's Motrin for teething or fever 1/2 tsp = 2.5cc every 6-8 hrs

Tylenol is toxic, do not give for teething at this age.

Nasal congestion can be relieved by upright positioning, Ocean nose drops to clear secretions and your bulb syringe.

- Try not to offer bottle/feed during night.
- Try to let baby self-soothe at night
- May offer cereal and Stage 3 solid foods

- May offer table foods if sitting up well.
- Never leave a baby unattended when feeding
- Call office for fever > 101.
- Nurse advice 210-22-NURSE Through the Methodist Children's Hospital
- Bring IMMUNIZATION RECORD to all well child visits.

Developmental milestones: Happy to see you, smiles, sits well, pulls to stand, "cruises" around furniture, mama, dada, bye-bye

NEXT WELL CHILD VISIT @ 12 months of age. Must be after birthday.

BY YOUR CHILD'S 1ST BIRTHDAY THEY SHOULD

- WAVE BYE-BYE
- WAVE 3 "WORDS" "MA", "DA" AND "BA"
- RESPOND TO THE WORD "NO"

CONSIDER A FORWARD FACING CAR SEAT WHEN YOUR CHILD WALKS WELL AND WEIGHS > 20LBS

Each baby develops in his own manner, the developmental milestones alert you to the changes you can expect as your child gets older.

Call our office to review your child's development if

- Does not ever crawl or move toward an object
- Does not search for objects/play "peek a boo"
- No verbal sounds
- Does not appear to be interested in pictures, objects or toys
